Lot 297: COLT MODEL 1860 ARMY REVOLVER, round cylinder, New York barrel address, three screw frame, serial #60783, inspector markings. Along with a period holster. Two pieces total. Very good condition, marring to barrel, wear to end of barrel, cuts to grips. **SOLD FOR \$2,970.00**

Lot 298: U. S. MODEL 1861 SPRINGFIELD RIFLE-MUSKET, lockplate marked "U.S. / SPRINGFIELD" and "1861", three barrel bands, brass buttplate, original ramrod with tulip end and swelled shank. Very good to fine condition, some very light rust and spotting, trigger guard slightly loose. **SOLD FOR \$1,760.00**

Lot 299: U. S. MODEL 1816 HARPERS FERRY CONVERSION MUSKET, lockplate marked "HARPERS / FERRY / FERRY CONVERSION 1826" and with eagle above "US", barrel stamped "VP" above eagle head, Belgian alteration to percussion, three barrel bands, ramrod appears to be original, most mountings stamped with an 8. Very good condition, light overall pitting, stock with small break at rear of hammer. **SOLD FOR \$1,430.00**

Lot 300: UNMARKED SMITH CARBINE, percussion breechloader, no barrel band, brass buttplate, no markings or serial number located. Very good condition, stock with small copper patch under butt and minor cracking and loss to forearm. **SOLD FOR \$605.00**

MODEL MUSKET, lockplate unmarked, barrel stamped "GF" PERCUSSION and "PU", stock with inspector's marking, three barrel bands, ramrod appears to be original, fitted with a bayonet stamped "US". Very good condition with light pitting and rust, small break and some marring to stock. **SOLD FOR \$935.00**

Lot 302: RICHMOND ARMORY RIFLE-MUSKET, lockplate marked "C.S. / RICHMOND, VA" and "1862", barrel marked with VP and eagle head, iron buttplate, iron ramrod, retains only one barrel band. NOTE: Authenticity not verified, sold strictly "AS IS". Stock reduced in length, stock with small losses and some marring, light rust. **SOLD FOR \$1,045.00**

Lot 303: U. S. MODEL 1841 CONTRACT PERCUSSION RIFLE, lockplate marked "ROBBINS / & / LAWRENCE / U.S." and "WINDSOR VT / 1848", brass patch box, retains only one brass barrel band. Stock reduced in length, loss to stock above lockplate, lacking hammer screw, light rust to barrel. **SOLD FOR \$467.50**

Lot 304: U. S. MODEL 1841 CONTRACT PERCUSSION RIFLE, lockplate marked "ROBBINS / & / LAWRENCE / U.S." and "WINDSOR VT / 1851", brass patch box, retains only one brass barrel band. Barrel and stock reduced in length, otherwise very good. **SOLD FOR \$522.50**

Lot 305: COLT 1971 ROBERT E. LEE REVOLVER, serial #4704 REL, with original walnut COMMEMORATIVE case and accoutrements. Excellent condition with some light tarnishing. **SOLD FOR \$495.00**

Lot 306: UNIDENTIFIED PERCUSSION MUSKET, lockplate marked "859", barrel stamped "FF", two barrel bands, ramrod of unknown association. Very good condition with some wear and small cracks to stock. **SOLD FOR \$522.50**

Lot 307: U. S. MODEL 1861 SPRINGFIELD RIFLE-MUSKET, lockplate marked "U.S. / SPRINGFIELD" and "1861", top of barrel stamped "J. W. LOHR" and "1861", US on tang of buttplate, retains only one barrel band. Barrel and stock reduced in length, lacking lockplate screws, pitting and rust, not operable. **SOLD FOR \$154.00**

Lot 308: COLT MODEL 1849 POCKET REVOLVER, 5-shot round cylinder, New York barrel address, serial #158399. Good condition with much pitting, not operable. **SOLD FOR \$495.00**

Lot 309: UNIDENTIFIED RIFLE-MUSKET, percussion breechloader, iron buttplate, barrel stamped "ELG" above a star, no other markings located. Stock with an old repair at rear of hammer, unknown completeness, normal wear. **SOLD FOR \$176.00**

Lot 310: UNIDENTIFIED PERCUSSION MUSKET, lockplate marked "860", two barrel bands. Stock probably reduced in length, other losses to stock, expected wear. **SOLD FOR \$165.00**
